All programs/services offered by the Chickasaw Nation are for **tribal citizens only**. No student shall be considered for funding who does not have a Chickasaw Nation citizenship card or citizenship confirmation. **Applications and documentation can no longer be submitted by fax.** All applications **must be in the education services office before or on established deadlines – Spring semester – Feb. 1st / Summer semester - June 15th / Fall semester* – Sept. 1st.**

Chikasha Holitoplichi – Laptop Scholarship Program

The scholarship is limited to full-time students (who have completed at least 30 college credit hours) and part-time graduate and doctoral students currently enrolled at and accredited institution for higher education with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Eligibility is limited to one laptop throughout his/her college career. The Chickasaw Nation and education services department are not responsible for any expenses incurred for warranty work, technical issues or upgrades. Not available during the summer semester.

* Current official college transcript showing classification.

Chikasha Holitoplichi – Incentive Program Classification Change

Eligibility is limited to one award per student per classification beginning his/her sophomore year in college. Undergraduate students currently enrolled must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at the end of each classification change.

1. For undergraduates:

Must apply any time during the range of the following hours per each classification:

- a. Sophomore – 30 to 59 hours completed - \$500
b. Junior – 60 to 89 hours completed - \$500
c. Senior – 90 to 124 hours completed - \$500

Failure to apply during the range of hours of a classification will result in a student foregoing the incentive for that classification. Student would then only be eligible for his/her next classification incentive.

2. For graduate degrees:

- a. 30 hours completed of graduate work - \$500

3. For professional degrees (juris doctorate, medical doctor, etc.)

- a. 2nd yr. (31 to 59 hours completed of professional degree) - \$500
b. 3rd yr. (60 to 89 hours completed of professional degree) - \$500
c. 4th yr. (90 to 124 hours completed of professional degree) - \$500

Documentation required with completed application:

* Current official college transcript showing classification.

Chikasha Holitoplichi – Graduation Stole Program

This stole is limited to students who will successfully earn a bachelor's degree or higher at an accredited institution for higher education. Eligibility is limited to one award per student per degree. Two award levels are recognized: students with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 – 3.49 and students with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. The student is responsible for obtaining permission, from his/her school, to wear the stole during commencement.

Documentation required with completed application:

* Application for the graduation stole must be made at the beginning of the semester.
