Through a two-year program, the selected candidate will earn an associate in science degree in the high-demand field of veterinary technology at Brevard Community College in Cocoa, Fla. A 7thGen Board member will provide part-time, paid employment in his veterinary practice. The academic program begins in January 2008.
